

GREETERS

- 1. Please Smile and Welcome All – it makes all the difference!**
2. Arrive at least 20 minutes prior to Mass time.
3. Make sure the lights are on in the gathering area and the front doors are unlocked.
4. All liturgical ministers are to check in with you upon arriving at Mass.
5. Stand in the gathering area to greet each visitor and parishioner.
- 6. Be hospitable especially to those alone or those you do not know.**
7. Offer each individual a misselette/song book.
8. Feel free to suggest they hang up their outerwear.
- 9. Keep the sanctuary doors closed to aid parishioners in a quiet time for prayer prior to the start of Mass.**
- 10. Ask special needs persons (wheel chair bound and others) if they need communion brought back to their seat. If they do please inform Father or Deacon of where they are sitting.**
11. Take your seats after Father has processed down the aisle.

NOTE:

If you are unable to fulfill your ministry as Greeter at the appointed Mass time, please find a replacement. Do not expect the Deacon to find a replacement for you.
