COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Building and Grounds – Mike told us the roof meeting went very well. We had 2 bids for sure. The difference between the bids is labor and equipment (union versus non-union) because of the windows installation. The first bid from Iossi is \$26,784 (scissors lift) and the second bid from Builders Sales/Service is \$37,626 (scaffolding and \$414 for permit) which covers windows and the leaks in the tower. The in the kitchen wall is repaired and the rest will be done in approximately 2 weeks. The insulation bids were from IA/IL Taylor Insulation, Quad City Insulation, and BG Construction.

Christian Service – Church United dinner was held on May 10. The Kahl home has been doing great. The people do enjoy the parishners coming to interact with them while playing bingo. A meeting is scheduled on May 8th at 6:30 pm to meet with others interested in social action projects.
